

**EMPOWERING WOMEN THROUGH TECHNICAL
EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM**
Due June 30th or December 30th

Applicants must be a female resident of Wayne County, Ohio (high school students or adults) who have completed career training or GED/high school diploma preparation through the Wayne County Schools Career Center (WCSCC), WCSCC/Adult & Community Education or WCSCC/ABLE. Applicants must be enrolled or enrolling in an accredited, not-for-profit, post-secondary educational institution (i.e. university, college, technical, or vocational school), with a course of study leading to a credentialed career with a “living wage”.

High School applicants must have a minimum of a 3.00 cumulative GPA (on a 4.00 point scale) during their senior year and adults must have a minimum of a 3.50 cumulative GPA (on a 4.00 scale) for all career training classes completed at the WCSCC or have successfully prepared for and completed their GED or high school diploma through WCSCC/ABLE.

First preference will be given to applicants who are enrolled or enrolling at OSU-ATI, have financial need, and demonstrate a motivation to succeed.

Previous recipients may re-apply, based on maintaining a 2.7 cumulative GPA, enrolled at least 6 hours per semester term or equivalent, and being in good standing with the educational institution.
